This framework, based on Gramsci's concept of hegemony, posits that powerholders rely on familiar and commonly accepted ideas to present issues in a way that supports their policy agenda while dissenters try to either directly challenge those hegemonic ideas (such as directly challenging the concept of "patriotism") or to harness hegemonic ideas to reframe the debate in their favor (such as asserting that "dissent is patriotic").
